The Problem - Incest

"It is actually reported that there is a sexual immorality among you, and of a kind that does not even occur among pagans: a man has his father's wife." (5:1)

• John Chrysostom (347 - 407) "there was another sin committed there, namely, a person who had slept with his stepmother not only escaped rebuke but even became a leader of the people...."

Paul's Response

- Directed at Man and Church
 - Hand the Man Over to Satan
 - Stop Association
 - Yeast and Passover
 - Judge Those Inside

The Problem

Church Disputes Before Pagan Courts

"If any of you has a dispute with another, dare
he take it before the ungodly for judgment
instead of before the saints?" (6:1)

Paul's Teaching

- Background:
 - Roman Law Allowed Jewish Disputes
 Settled By Jewish System
 - Roman Courts Resolved With Strong
 Favoritism Toward Status and Wealth
- Church Handles
 - Involved in Judging World and Angels
 - Effect on Watching World

Prostitution and Sexual Immorality (6:12-20)

The Problems

- Porneo (πορνεω) "Prostitution / Sexual Immorality"
- Background Differences
 - "Mistresses we keep for the sake of pleasure, concubines for the daily care of the body, but wives to bear us legitimate children."
 Demosthenes, *Orations*, 59.122
 - Temple Prostitution

Paul's Teaching

- "Everything is permissible for me' -- but not everything is beneficial. 'Everything is permissible for me' -- but I will not be mastered by anything." (6:12)
- Effect
- Flee Sexual Immorality, Honor God

Paul's Teaching: Celibacy Within Marriage

"Now for the matters you wrote about: It is good for a man not to marry." (7:1)

Or

"It is good for a man not to have sexual relations with a woman."

Paul's Teaching: Celibacy Within Marriage

"Now for the matters you wrote about: It is good for a man not to marry/have sexual relations."

- Each Should Have Spouse B/c Sexual Immorality
- Mutual Duty Don't Deprive Unless
 - 1. Mutual Consent
 - 2. For A Time
 - 3. Devotion To Prayer
 - 4. Come together Again Satan's Temptation

Paul's Teaching Single or Married?

"Now to the Unmarried and Widows..." (7:8)
"Now about Virgins..." (7:25)

- Good to Stay Unmarried, but Better to Marry than Burn With Passion (7:8-9)
- If Married, Stay Married (7:10-11)
- Paul says, "because of the present crisis, I think it is good for you to remain as you are..." (7:26)

Paul's Teaching Mixed-Faith Marriages

- If Unbeliever Willing to Live in Union, No Divorce (7:12-14)
 - Effect on Spouse and Children

Food Sacrificed To Idols (Chapter 8)

The Problems

- Eat or Not?
- Conscience Issues

Paul's Teaching

- There is No Truth to Idols
- So Eat Without Worry
- But Careful With Weak Consciences

Ministry and Money

- The Problem: Paul Worked and Preached
- Right For Ministry to Be Job
- Also Right To Minster and Work Other Job
- The Key is to Minister!
