Confirming Jewish Christians in their Faith

Messiah

- 1. Messiah Prophet (Elijah)
- 2. Messiah Priest (Moses)
- 3. Messiah King (David)

Temptations

- 40 Day Fast
- Echoes Moses (Ex. 34:28)
 Elijah (I Kings 19:8)

Temptation One

- How Friendly!
- Food to a Starving Man
- Sustenance / Ideas from Satan or God?
 - "Man does not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God." Dt. 8:3

Temptation Two

- Move from Physical to Pride
- The Credential Challenge

Satan: "He will command his angels concerning you, and they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone" Ps. 91:11-12

Jesus: "It is also written: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test." Dt. 6:16

Temptation Three

 Satan to Fulfill God's Mission Quicker and Easier

"Away from me, Satan! For it is written,
"Worship Yahweh your God, and serve only
him." Dt. 6:13

Beatitudes

Latin beatitudo: "Blessed, Happy, Fortunate"

Poor in Spirit Kingdom of Heaven /Persecuted for Him Comforted Mourn Inherit the Earth Meek Filled with Hunger For it Righteousness BE Merciful Shown Mercy Be Pure in Heart See God Be Called Child of —Be a Peacemaker God

Salt and Light

Permeate the World and Culture with God
(Where we Work, Play, Live, Socialize)
(Who we see casually, Professionally,
Accidentally)

What is the "Law"?

• Different purposes of law

The Law

- Not Just the Letter, the Spirit
- Murder -- Anger
- Adultery -- Lust
- Divorce -- Sin w/o Unfaithfulness
- Oaths -- Honor Your Word
- Retribution -- Forgiveness
- Enemies -- Love, not Hate

Holy Living

- Give Privately, not to Show Off
- Simple Straightforward Prayers
 - (Praise, God's Work, Our Needs, Repentance, Forgiveness, and Protection)
- Fast Privately
- Seek God -- The "Heart / Treasure" Rule
- Don't Worry

Lord's Prayer

• Text - "for thine ... amen"

Holy Living

- Don't Judge -- Speck or Plank?
- Ask, Seek, Knock
- Rare and Narrow
- Watch for Wolves
 - Verbal acclamation not enough!
- Build Wisely
