We find our answers in some problems at Corinth




Some came in claiming to be "super apostles" putting down Paul and his teaching as inferior




Seeking to lead the Corinthians "astray from a sincere and pure devotion to Christ" (2 Cor. 11:3)






Though there is nothing to be gained by it, I will go on to visions and revelations of the Lord.




I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven ... this man was caught up into paradise.




And he heard things that cannot be told, which man may not utter. On behalf of this man, I will boast, but on my own behalf I will not boast, except of my weaknesses.






