BACKGROUND

- Second Samuel
- Originally one scroll with First Samuel
- NOT written by Samuel
- Covers early monarchy of Israel
- II Samuel concentrates on King David

THE KINGSHIP

- Saul suicides
- Amalekite deceives (stupid move!)
- David genuinely laments
- David annointed king in Judah

DIVISION OF ISRAEL

- Northern tribes "Israel"
- Southern tribes "Judah"

CIVIL WAR

- David (< 30) king of South (Judah)
- Ish-Bosheth (40) king of North (Israel)
- David's general Joab
- Ish's general Abner
- Treachery and bloodshed

DAVID'S RISINGS

- Heart is tuned into God's.
 - Honoring timing
 - Honoring annointing
- Politically wise.
 - Efforts to reach out to north
 - Jerusalem as capital city

DAVID'S ACHEIVEMENTS

- Militarily
 - Capture of Jerusalem
 - Defeat of neighboring enemies
- Governmental organization
- Religious contributions
 - Movement of ark
 - Plans for temple
 - Preist and music organization

DAVID'S SINS

- Adultery with Bathsheba
- Murder of Uriah
- Nathan's allegory
- David's repentance
 - Psalm 51

SIN'S CONSEQUENCES

- Four punishments re Bathsheba
- Sword not depart from David's house (II Sam. 12:10)
- 2. Evil rise up from David's house (II Sam. 12:11)
- 3. Public adultery of David's wives (II Sam. 12:11)
- 4. Child to die (II Sam. 12:14)

1 – SWORD

- Absalom (son) kills Amnon (son) for fornicating with Tamar (daughter).
- Joab (general) kills Absalom (son).
- Solomon (son) kills Adonijah (son).

2 – EVIL FROM HOUSE

- Amon (son) Adulterates with Tamar (daughter)
- Absalom (son) leads coup
- Adonijah (son) tries to take throne

3 - WIVES

 Absalom (son) goes into concubines on roof for all to see

4 – CHILD DIES

Seven days after birth.
