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
Be careful of pseudo-intellectualism

My issues: Primary vs. Secondary Research



"Church structure was an issue in the 2d and 3d century"

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FACT: Local church structure was also important in Paul's time

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FACT: Paul is not dead at the end of Acts

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FACT: Paul uses different words in every epistle

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FACT: These are personal letters not church letters

FACT: These are personal letters not church letters


FACT: This is later in Paul's life
